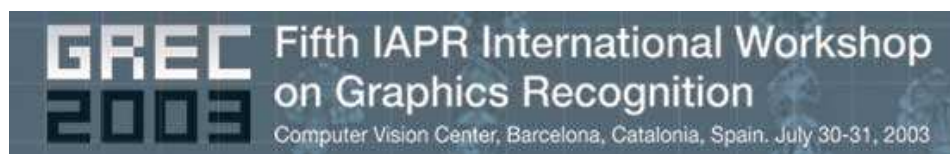

- **Fifth IAPR International Workshop on Graphics Recognition (GREC2003)**



- Held at the Computer Vision Center (Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona).
- 48 papers were received (43 papers accepted).
- 47 registered participants:
 - Belgium (1), Brasil (1), Canada (1), China (4), France (10), Germany (2), Ireland (3), Japan (2), Korea (3), Mexico (1), Singapore (1), Spain (9), Switzerland (1), United Kingdom (3), USA (5).
- Program with 8 sessions:
 - Platforms, architectures and document knowledge models.
 - Technical documents, maps and charts.
 - Perceptual organization, indexing and graphical signatures.
 - Image Analysis and Low-Level Processing.
 - Symbol Recognition, graphical matching and classification.
 - On-Line Processing and User Interfaces.
 - Demonstrations, Industrial Projects.
 - Performance Evaluation, Contests.
- Post-workshop Springer-LNCS book with selected papers.

- Arc segmentation Contest
 - chair Liu Wenyin.
 - Continuation of the contest held in Kingston.
 - 2 participants.
- Symbol Recognition Contest
 - chairs Ernest Valveny and Philippe Dosch.
 - 5 participants.
 - A benchmark dataset of 7000 images and different evaluation protocols (scaling, rotation, noise, deformation, scalability, etc.)
