The TC-10 and GREC 2013 organizing committee are glad to announce that Tenth IAPR International Workshop on GRaphics Recognition will be held at Lehigh University, Bethlehem, PA, on August 20-21, 2013. As tradition wants it, GREC will be held close to the ICDAR conference and will try to keep its highly interactive, productive and open atmosphere, making it the place to be for discussing current trends of graphics recognition, for keeping up to date with recent advances, but also for discovering more prospective works and interacting with both young and more experienced researchers in the field. Transportation between both events will be organized.



ICDAR Double Submission Policy

The Program Committee will strictly enforce the IAPR Ethics Guidelines (especially, but not exclusively, with respect to self-plagiarism and multiple submissions of similar work). Given the overlapping submission calendar between the 2013 ICDAR and GREC editions, parallel submission of papers to both events will be tolerated under specific conditions:

- authors submitting similar papers to both events should explicitly notify the GREC Program Committee (and the GREC Program Committee only) by mentioning it in the paper;
- submission to ICDAR automatically and irreversibly takes precedence over GREC, and subsequent acceptance of a paper (oral or poster) at ICDAR will result in its immediate and irrevocable removal from the GREC process;
- authors deciding to withdraw accepted papers from ICDAR after the selection process will not have their papers reintegrated in GREC.

Contests:

As for previous editions, GREC organizers encourage graphics-related competitions, and call upon volunteers wanting to organize any of those (on previously existing themes or on new subjects) to contact us at Bart.Lamiroy@loria.fr or Jean-Marc.Ogier@univ-lr.fr.

- Full paper submission (6 pages) April 8th, 2013
- Acceptance notification: May 15th, 2013

Call for Nominations: ICDAR 2013 Awards

The ICDAR Award Program is an established program designed to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the field of Document Analysis and Recognition in one or more of the following areas:

- Research
- Training of students
- Research/Industry interaction
- Service to the profession

Every two years, two awards categories are presented. Namely, the IAPR/ICDAR Young Investigator Award (less than 40 years old at the time the award is made), and the IAPR/ICDAR Outstanding Achievements Award. Each award will consist of a token gift and a suitably inscribed certificate. The recipient of the Outstanding Achievements award will be invited to give the opening key note speech at the ICDAR 2013 conference, introduced by the recipient from the previous conference.

Nominations are invited for the ICDAR 2013 Awards in both categories.

The nomination packet should include the following:

- 1. A nominating letter (1 page) including a brief citation to be included in the certificate.
- 2. A brief vitae (2 pages) of the nominee highlighting the accomplishments being recognized.
- 3. Supporting letters (1 page each) from 3 active researchers from at least 3 different countries.

A nomination is usually put forward by a researcher (preferably from a different Institution than the nominee) who is knowledgeable of the scientific achievements of the nominee, and who organizes letters of support.

Submission procedure is strictly confidential, and self nominations are not allowed.



Dear Researcher,

Many researchers in Optical Music Recognition have proposed staff removal algorithms in order to make easier the segmentation and enhance the accuracy of music symbol recognition. However, the staff removal task cannot be considered a solved problem, especially when dealing with ancient/degraded handwritten music scores.

We would like to attract your attention on the Second edition of the "Music Scores - Staff Removal competition" that will be held in conjunction with ICDAR/GREC 2013. For this second edition, we have generated semi-synthetic images using two new types of degradations that emulate old and degraded handwritten musical documents:

We hope that the new set of images will be challenging for the community.

We invite all researchers in document analysis and recognition to register and participate in the competition.
